Public Works Report

Gravel Roads

Graders are continuing their efforts on soft areas, areas with washboards, and areas with potholes.

Patch gravelling is currently underway, and crews are coming out of the Varty Stockpile site and the Smith Aggregate Pit.

Surfaced Roads

Asphalt repairs are still ongoing, including parking lot maintenance at the new building.

Chip Seal on the Red Deer River Access Road was pushed back due to weather and was anticipated to begin September 19th/20th. Should poor weather persist, it will be pushed into the week of September 24th.

Additional line painting, on approximately 25 kilometers of surfaced road, is anticipated to take place the week of September 24th.

Route & Seal crack fill on Prairie Creek Road will be completed the week of September 24th. Blow & Seal crack fill, on the Beaver Flat Road, will also be completed the week of September 24th.

Crews are still patching any surfaced roads, and, SB-90 dust suppressions requiring maintenance prior to the winter season.

Crews have begun preparing for the winter season. As such, trucks are being rigged up with plows and crews have been prepping both salt sheds to begin the sand/salt pickling operations.

Maintenance

Gravel crushing, within Smith Pit, located at NE 31-37-08-W5M, began on September 17th, 2108. Once completed in the Smith Pit, crushing will commence within the Martin Pit, located at NE 13-39-08-W5M.

Condor Lift Station, Phase 2 Upgrades, are continuing. Upgrades are scheduled to be completed by October 15th, 2018.

Construction on BF 70149, located on Range Road 6-0, approximately 6 km south of Caroline (SW 31-35-05-W5M), was completed on September 21st, 2018.

Construction on BF 13970, located on Township Road 37-3, over the North Raven River (NE 18-37-05-W5M) has been completed. Final inspection to be done on Wednesday, September 26th.

Construction on BF 09970, located on Range Road 6-1 (Bingley Road), over Lobstick Creek (NW 36-40-06-W5M), to begin on October 5th, 2018. Construction is scheduled to be completed by October 31st, 2018, weather dependant.

Flushing, of sanitary lines, within the hamlets of Leslieville, Condor and Nordegg has been completed.

Gravel Road Rehabilitation

The Shoulder Pull Crew on Twp. Rd. 37-2, east of Hwy. 761, has 300 m of the 3500 m project remaining.

The Re-Hab Crew moving to Twp. Rd. 39-0, east of the Everdell Road (Clearwater Estates) sometime this week, weather permitting.

Crew on Rge. Rd. 5-4, south of Twp. Rd. 38-4 has roughed in 900 m of the 1200 m project. Nothing else has changed due to inclement weather.

Base/Pave Projects

Taimi Road – Pidherney's had been working on restoring the settled area prior to inclement weather and had approximately 75% of the repair in place prior to weather shut down.

Nordegg Manufactured Home Park

PME had been working on lot grading to prepare for shallow utility installation prior to stopping for inclement weather.

West Country Road Project

Northfork Road Phase 2

Netook Construction has been maintaining traffic though work area as inclement weather has stopped work since September 11th.
